

IMPORTANT EMPLOYEE NOTICE

The Wisconsin Food Code requires employees to inform the manager on duty if he/she is ill with the following:

- Any foodborne illness (see your supervisor for a list)
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Fever
- Jaundice
(*yellowish discoloration of skin, eyes or inside of mouth*)
- Sore throat with fever
- Wound or boil that contains pus on exposed skin

If you are ill, you must not work!

The Wisconsin Food Code does not allow you to work in the restaurant if you have the following health issues:

- Diagnosed with a foodborne illness
(see your supervisor for list)
Requires approval from health department to return to work
- Vomiting
Symptoms must cease for at least 24 hours before returning to work
- Diarrhea
Symptoms must cease for at least 24 hours before returning to work

The Wisconsin Food Code does not allow you to work around food, utensils or equipment if you have the following health issues:

- Fever
- Sore throat with fever
- Wound or boil that contains pus

If you have jaundice, your supervisor will let you know if you can work.
